This is an official statement of the 2010 Census population and housing unit counts for Woodward city, Iowa. These counts reflect boundary updates reported to the U.S. Census Bureau effective as of January 1, 2013. These counts also reflect any changes previously made to 2010 Census counts under the Census Bureau's Count Question Resolution Program.
