State of Iowa Signature Requirements for U.S. Representative District 1 June 3, 2014, Primary Election

Candidates for United States Representative District 1 must collect signatures on nomination petitions. The number of signatures needed depends on the candidate's political party affiliation. The signature calculation is based on the number of votes cast for the party's candidate for president in the 2012 General Election. Each petition must meet both of the following requirements:

1. Minimum Total Signatures

All candidates are advised to collect more than the required minimum number of signatures. The total number of signatures must equal at least 1% of the votes cast in congressional district 1 for the party's candidate for president in the 2012 General Election, rounded up to the next whole number:

Democratic Party = 2,256	Republican Party = 1,708
(225,585 x .01)	(170,753 x .01)

2. Minimum 10 Counties

Signatures for candidates in this district must be collected in at least 10 counties. The minimum number of signatures that must be collected in each of the 10 counties is equal to 2% of the votes cast for president by the voters of that county in the 2012 General Election, rounded up to the next whole number. Each page of the petition may have signatures from only one county.
