

## Inactive Voter with Voted Absentee Ballot

Dear

You requested an absentee ballot for the election to be held on Tuesday, \_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_ and your voted absentee ballot has been returned to the county auditor's office.

However, a voter registration card was also mailed to you and it was returned by the post office as undeliverable. As a result, your voter registration record is now "Inactive." Please be aware that your absentee ballot cannot be counted until your registration is restored to "Active" status.

To restore your voter registration to "Active" status, you must return a copy of one of the following forms of identification to the county auditor's office:

1. Current and valid (unexpired) photo ID such as a driver's license, non-driver's ID, U.S. passport, military ID, etc.

**OR**

2. One of the following showing your name and current address:
  - Utility bill (including a cell phone bill),
  - Bank statement,
  - Paycheck,
  - Government check, or
  - Other government document.

The photocopies of documents must be received in the county auditor's office by the time the absentee and special voters precinct board convenes to count absentee ballots on \_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_.

If the copies of the documents are not received by that time, the absentee and special voters precinct board will be required to challenge your absentee ballot.
