


# Removing popup windows – Windows Vista


This document shows how to remove the most common popups in Windows Vista.

Popups: User Account Control




Click Start


Click Control Panel



If you see this screen, click “Classic View”



Double-click User Accounts




Click "Turn User Account Control on or off"




A similar window will pop up

Click Continue




Remove the checkmark by “Use User Account Control”

Click OK




Save your work before restarting


Popup: Check your computer security




Open the Control Panel



Double-click "Security Center"



Click "Change the way Security Center alerts me"




Click "Don't notify me and don't display the icon (not recommended)"

Close the window


Popup: Windows can't check for updates




Open the Control Panel



Double-click "Windows Update"



Click “Change settings”



Select “Never check for updates (not recommended)”


Remove the checkmark by “Include recommended updates”

Click OK
