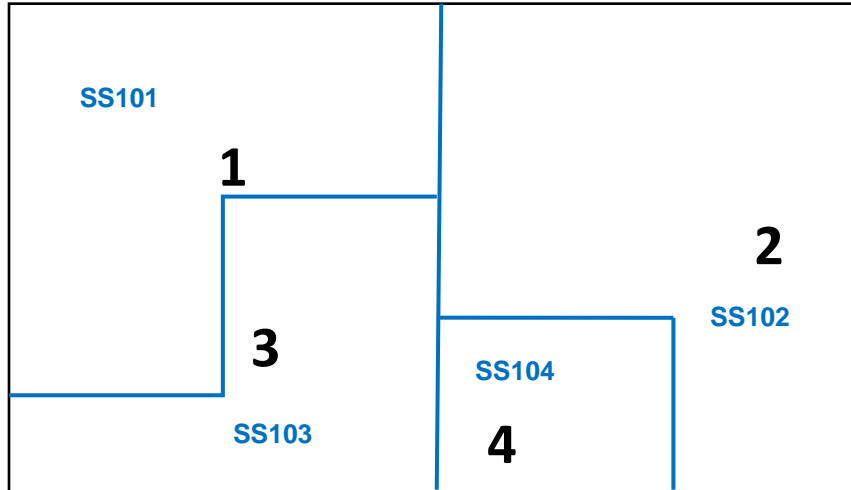


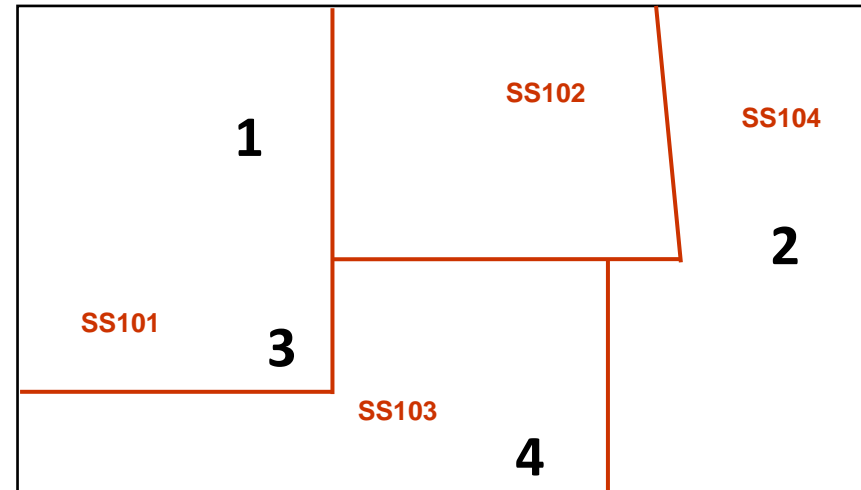
Holdover Senate District Example

Assumed Date: February 1, 2012

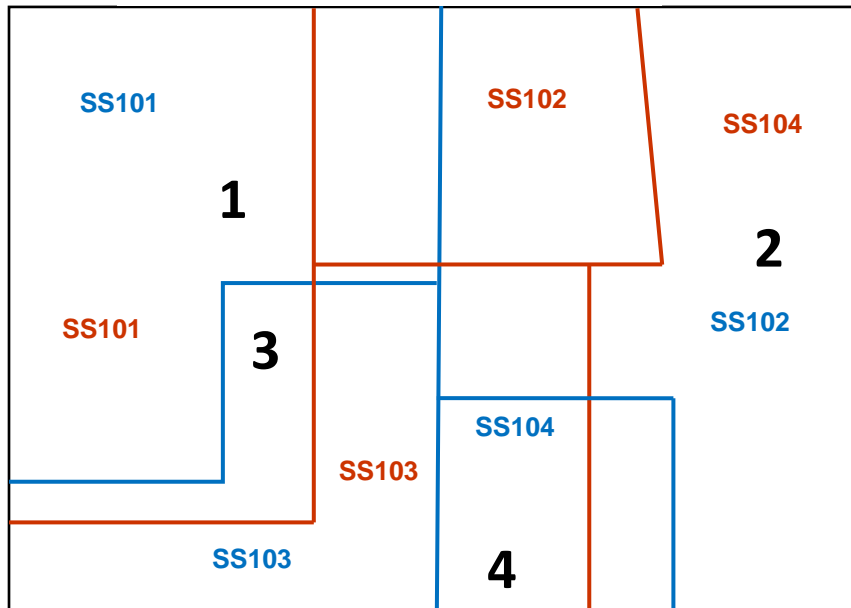
Map 1: Before Redistricting

Maps 1 & 2 Combined



Explanation:

- SS101 must appear on the ballot if either Senator 1 or 3 does not resign. If 1 or 3 resigns, the other will represent the new SS101 and the seat will appear on the ballot again in 2014.
- SS102 will appear on the ballot at the 2012 General Election because it is an even-numbered district.
- SS103 will not appear on the ballot because an incumbent senator resides in the new district.
- SS104 will not appear on the ballot at the 2012 General Election because it is an even-numbered district.

*Numerals 1-4 indicate residence locations for senators in this example.
