SCATTERING received six 6


We therefore declare JOHN JUDGE duly elected to the office of State Senator, Forty-Sixth District, for the residue of the term ending on the second day of January, 2001.

In testimony whereof, We have hereunto set our hands and caused to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Iowa.


