Poll workers are the key ingredient to running our polling places on election day. They assist voters with disabilities, issue ballots, answer questions, and guide voters through the voting process.

To be a poll worker, you must be:

- Registered to vote in the state of Iowa
- At least 17 years of age
- A resident of the county you serve in
- And complete the required training
